Credit Hours and Tuition Fees

Students are required to study complementary courses as determined by the Graduate Studies Committee in the department.

- For the Thesis Track: Students must complete a minimum of (24) credit hours at the (600) level, successfully pass them, and submit a thesis contributing original knowledge, for which (9) credit hours are allocated, along with a successful defense examination.
- For the Comprehensive Exam Track: Students must complete a minimum of (33) credit hours at the (600) level, successfully pass them and pass the comprehensive exam.
- Tuition fees per credit hour are 70 Jordanian Dinars for Jordanian students, and 225 USD for international students.

Study Plan Overview

The curriculum of the Master's program in Financial and Banking Sciences at Yarmouk University includes a range of mandatory and elective courses aimed at providing students with fundamental and advanced knowledge in financial management, investment management, financial risks, financial engineering, financial markets, and econometrics. Additionally, there is a systematic study of research methodologies and standard economics.

Students can opt for either the Thesis track, conducting original research in the field, or the Comprehensive track, which involves an extensive study of core and elective courses along with passing a comprehensive examination at the end of the program. The program offers extensive opportunities for specialization in advanced areas such as financial planning and forecasting, international banking and financial markets, contemporary financial issues, preparing students for various career opportunities in diverse banking and financial sectors.
