This is achieved through a focus on leadership and entrepreneurship skills that align with the requirements of this stage.

Targeted Groups and Accepted Majors

1- Student must have a bachelor's degree as a minimum, preferably within the disciplines of economics and administrative sciences, engineering in all its branches, and the disciplines of the Faculty of Computer and Information Technology, from an accredited university at Yarmouk University.

2- Preferably someone who has at least two years of practical experience in one of the administrative/leadership positions.

3- Passing the English language requirement in accordance with the decisions of the Higher Education Council.

Credit Hours and Tuition Fees

The study plan contains 33 credit hours.

The price of a credit hour is 100 Jordanian dinars for a Jordanian student, and 300 US dollars for an international student.
