The Master's program in Social Studies Curriculum and Instruction complements other Master's programs related to academic studies in various fields. The program provides adequate support for all teachers interested in pursuing educational supervision in various social science disciplines and works in schools. It also meets the needs of experts working in curriculum development and analysis, as well as practitioners interested in the field of training.

Targeted Groups and Accepted Majors

- 1. Meet the requirements set out by the Higher Education Council.
- 2. Hold a bachelor's degree in a subject that qualifies them for specialized study in the department they wish to enrol in, according to the criteria set by the department.
- 3. Pass the required language proficiency test for admission to the program, according to the Higher Education Council's decisions.
- 4. Any other conditions determined by relevant committees and councils.

Job Areas

The Master's program in Social Studies Curriculum and Instruction provides graduates with

employment opportunities in various fields, including:

1. Working as specialized social studies teachers at the elementary and secondary

education levels.

2. Assuming supervisory roles in educational institutions to monitor and enhance the

performance of teachers in the field of social studies.

3. Employment in ministries of education or educational institutions to develop and author

social studies curricula and textbooks.

4. Conducting workshops and training courses for teachers and educational supervisors to

enhance their educational and teaching skills.

5. Providing educational consultancy to educational institutions, research centers, and

development agencies to improve the quality of education in the field of social studies.

6. Managing and implementing educational projects aimed at improving and developing

the educational process in social studies.

7. Engaging in academic and field research in social studies and publishing studies and

research in scientific journals.

8. Collaborating with international non-governmental organizations and international

bodies concerned with education and educational development in the field of social

studies.

Credit Hours and Tuition Fees

The Master's program requires students to complete 33 credit hours.

The cost per credit hour is:

- Jordanian students: 70 Jordanian Dinars.

- Non-Jordanian students: 225 US Dollars.

Study Plan Overview

A master's degree is awarded in the field of Social Studies Curriculum and Instruction after completing the following requirements:

- 1. Fulfilment of the degree requirements.
- 2. Completion of any remedial courses determined by the Graduate Studies Committee in the department.
- 3. Completion of a minimum of 33 credit hours at the 600 level, with successful completion and a cumulative GPA of no less than 75%.
