Master's in Business Law

Program Overview

The Master's in Business Law program, with its two thesis and comprehensive tracks, provides a broad educational experience in business organization at the national and international level. This program will enable its members to develop knowledge and skills regarding the legal rules that regulate commercial activities and the business environment. It will also enable them to deal with work problems from the point of view of the law by knowing the legal rules that enable them to provide solutions to these problems in accordance with the provisions of the law. Thus developing their economic activities and businesses.

The peculiarity of this program is that its members are not limited to those holding a bachelor's degree in law, as the program opens the door to everyone who holds a bachelor's degree to be one of its students, regardless of their specialization at that stage.

Success in this program requires studying (33) credit hours distributed between compulsory requirements and optional requirements, in addition to the comprehensive exam. The student can also transfer to the thesis track if the conditions specified by law are met.

Program Objectives

1. Providing students of all specializations with the opportunity to expand their legal knowledge in the field of business environment, economic activity and investment, and to understand the legal rules regulating these activities in a sound and integrated manner, through exposure to corporate law and insurance legislation.
2. Providing and enhancing the areas of economic activity in the public and private sectors with distinguished graduates with sufficient legal knowledge in a way that enables them to develop their businesses and move economic activity within a sound legal framework.
3. Developing skills related to analyzing the legal problems facing businessmen and finding appropriate solutions within a sound legal framework.
4. Strengthening scientific research and legal studies related to the business sector within a sound methodological plan that reaches logical results and recommendations that are applicable in practice. Which contributes to the development of this sector and finding legal solutions to the problems it faces.

Program Importance

The importance of the program is based on a scientific research study that includes the numbers of students and graduates, job applications at the Civil Service Commission, the opinion of civil society institutions such as unions and relevant associations, and the results of statistics on the need of the public and private labor market locally and regionally for specialization.

Attached is the required market need study.

(1) This program provides a broad educational experience in entrepreneurship at the national and international levels. This program will enable associates to develop knowledge and skills regarding the legal rules that regulate commercial activities and the business environment. It will also enable them to deal with work problems from the point of view of the law by knowing the legal rules that address these problems, which will enable them to provide solutions to these problems in accordance with the provisions of the law and thus develop their economic activities and businesses within a sound legal framework.

(2) This program is consistent with the general trend of encouraging the investment environment and drawing up the legal framework for the investment environment in Jordan by establishing and developing legal rules in line with this trend. Therefore, this program will provide investors and businessmen with the legal knowledge that will enable them to determine their rights, privileges, and duties and carry out their work in accordance with the principle Rule of law.

(3) The peculiarity of this program is that it does not restrict members to those holding a bachelor's degree in law, but rather opens this program to everyone who holds a bachelor's degree, regardless of specialization.

(4) The medical reputation enjoyed by the College of Law at Yarmouk University, as this has had a tangible positive impact on the steady increase in the number of Arab students studying at the college in the bachelor's and other master's programs, which is also what is hoped for in this program, which enhances the scientific standing of Jordan, Especially in the Arab Gulf countries, and because of the positive mutual effects between Jordan and the sister Arab countries.

Targeted Groups and Accepted Majors

1. Students who hold a bachelor's degree in law.
2. Students who hold a bachelor's degree in all specializations.

Job Areas

Credit Hours and Tuition Fees

The study plan consists of (33) credit hours.

The credit hour fee for a Jordanian student is (120) dinars, and for an international student (300) dollars per credit hour.

Study Plan Overview

The number of credit hours for the Master of Business Law program in the thesis and comprehensive tracks is (33) credit hours distributed between compulsory requirements and optional requirements in addition to the comprehensive exam. The student can also transfer to the thesis track if the conditions specified by law are met. The credit hours are distributed as follows: -

- Comprehensive track: Mandatory specialization requirements, numbering (24) credit hours, in addition to the comprehensive exam, and optional specialization requirements, numbering (9) credit hours.
- The thesis track: compulsory specialization requirements of (15) credit hours and (9) credit hours for the thesis, and optional specialization requirements of (9) credit hours.
