Program Overview

The Master's Program in Chemistry at Yarmouk University is one of the famous programs in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, as it aims to provide advanced education and specialized training in various fields of chemistry.

Program Objectives

- Providing the community with scientific and research cadres specialized in various fields of chemistry
- Qualifying program graduates to work in academic and industrial sectors.
- Promoting scientific research and technological development in various fields of chemistry.
- Developing the capabilities and skills necessary to solve problems and innovate in the field of various chemistry.

Targeted Groups and Accepted Majors

The program accepts bachelor's degree graduates in chemistry and sometimes related disciplines such as pharmaceutical industries.

Job Areas

Graduates of the program can work in academic research, various chemical industries and environmental institutions, in addition to working in academic teaching and scientific consulting.

Credit Hours and Tuition Fees

The program consists of 33 credit hours.

The fees for Jordanian students are 80 Jordanian dinars per credit hour. The fees for non-Jordanian students are 300 US dollars per credit hour.

Study Plan Overview

It includes an integrated set of cooperative courses, such as Advanced Organic Chemistry, Chemical Applications of Group Theory, Analytical Separation Methods andMolecular Structure and Spectroscopy, in addition to elective courses covering various theoretical specializations in chemistry. Modern laboratories are provided for teaching and editing the master's programmer.
