Program Overview

The Environmental Sciences Program is a pioneering program that combines different sciences. The program is designed to let students think critically to protect the environment and provide innovative environmental solutions to various environmental problems.

Program Objectives

This program aims to provide students with knowledge and skills related to the environment and scientific research skills by developing the necessary competencies to enable them to practice their future professions effectively.

Program Importance

Due to the large increase in population, the scarcity of natural resources, and the resulting environmental problems, it has become necessary to introduce academic environmental programs concerned with finding appropriate solutions to environmental problems.

Targeted Groups and Accepted Majors

The applicant for this program should:

1. Hold a B.Sc. degree in Environmental Sciences or any other related fields approved by the department.
2. Fulfill the English Language requirement according to university regulations.
3. Satisfy any other conditions approved by related committees and councils.

Job Areas

- In the private sector: includes NGOs and environmental offices.
- Teaching and research in the universities and schools.
- In the governmental sector: includes ministries of Environment.

Credit Hours and Tuition Fees

The program consists of 33 credit hours, with tuition fees of 80 Jordanian Dinars per credit hour for Jordanians, and 300 USD per credit hour for non-Jordanians.

Study Plan Overview

Master's Degree in Environmental Sciences is awarded on the completion of the following requirements:

1. The fulfillment of the conditions stated in the bylaws of awarding the master's degree at Yarmouk University.
2. Completion of the deficiency courses recommended by the higher studies committee in the department.
3. Completion of (33) credit hours of 600-level courses (with a minimum GPA of 75%).
